Introduction

In the Configuration > Logging section you can configure your logging settings to use in your web-store.

Store Page Parse Time

1. Go to the Admin Panel and click the **Configuration** link.
2. Then, select the **Logging** item.
3. Since the **Store Page Parce Time** item is highlighted, click the **Edit** button on the right.

- Tick the **True** button to store the time expended on page parsing. The parse time will be displayed in the special log file which is specified in the Log Destination (see below).
 - Tick the **False** button if you do not want to activate this feature.
4. Click in the **Update** button.

Log Destination

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Logging** item.
2. Select the **Log Destination** item in the grid and click the **Edit** button.

3. In the field there are directory and name of the log file containing the page parse time: /tmp/page_parse_time.log. The log file is automatically created by the system in the **tmp** folder on your server.
4. Click the **Update** button.

Log Date Format


1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Logging** item.
2. Select the **Log Date Format** item in the grid and click the **Edit** button.

3. In the field there is a date format for logging on the web-site. For example, the default format is "%d/%m/%Y %H:%M:%S". In the log file it will look like this: dd/mm/YY, HH:MM:SS. For example, 01/01/07, 12:10:05
4. Click the **Update** button.

Display The Page Parse Time

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Logging** item.
2. Select the **Display The Page Parse Time** item in the grid and click the **Edit** button.

- Tick the **True** button to display the Page Parse Time. The parse time will be displayed at the bottom of the page after executing any actions on the web-site, e.g. after clicking the links. *Note: The Store Page Parse Time feature must be enabled.*

- Tick the **False** button if you do not want to activate this feature.
3. Click the **Update** button.

Store Database Queries

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Logging** item.
2. Select the **Store Database Queries** item in the grid and click the **Edit** button.
